Teconnex is a light engineering company, whose activities include the design and manufacturing of clamps for Engine and Vehicle production, Marine, Chemical, Petrochemical, Oil and Gas Production, Pharmaceutical, Food and Beverage, Water treatment, Aerospace and Power systems industries. Diversification of company activities includes battery assembly and in-house machine building for TX Group sales.

We are an environmentally conscious company and as such we acknowledge the potential environmental impact that our operations may have on the environment.

The HS&E Steering Group of Teconnex Ltd endorses this policy and ensures it is compatible with the context and strategic direction of the Company. As such, the company is committed to the environmental management system (EMS) achieving its intended outcomes and the continual improvement of the EMS to enhance environmental performance.

This is facilitated through the setting of documented environmental objectives based on our significant environmental aspects, compliance obligations and considering our risks and opportunities.
